I'm really pleased that Australia has ratified the Kyoto Protocol. But it's a drop in the bucket compared to what's needed to turn around Australia's spiralling greenhouse pollution. What's needed are the measures in the Climate Protection Bill, drafted by community climate groups across Australia. I urge you to support this important Bill, and commit to introducing the visionary solutions it contains.

The Bill arrests Australia's contribution to climate change by: halving Australia's Greenhouse Gas Emissions by 2020 compared to 1990 levels, and making Australia Carbon Neutral by 2040; increasing funding for renewable energy; establishing national energy efficiency standards; preventing new coal power stations, coal mines and nuclear power plants; ending the logging of old growth forests, and ending subsidies to fossil fuel industries; and more. The responsibility for protecting our delicate and diverse planet for future generations belongs to everybody, not least to you as one of our elected representatives. Please let me know how you intend to respond to the Bill.
